Letter from our Pastor

A few days ago we saw on the news and read on newspapers about the floods that killed over 200 people in Spain. We hear stories of lives changing in a matter of hours and the country now having to prepare for its biggest peacetime disaster recovery operation.



In other parts of the world conflicts and wars have caused disasters, displacement, and peace is elusive. Such as in Ukraine, Gaza and Lebanon to name just a few.

On many occasions we hear about protests in different parts of the world because people want peace in Ukraine, peace in Gaza, peace in Lebanon and we pray for peace in Valencia and Spain as the country recovers from this tragedy.

As we prepare to celebrate Christmas one of the verses, we usually read is *Isaiah 9:6:*

"For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, **The Prince of Peace**"

Maybe in our personal lives peace has been elusive (a loss, an illness, an addiction, a broken relationship), and we try to find this peace. There is an invitation from Jesus Christ, the Prince of Peace, He wants to give us a peace that surpasses all understanding (See *Philippians 4:7*). This is not found in religion, entertainment or meditation. Peace is what Jesus gave to His disciples for He said, "Peace I leave with you; **My peace I give you**. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." *John 14:27*

Peace is found and received when we meet Jesus and allow Him to lead us. Because as Someone wrote "Peace is not the absence of trouble. Peace is the presence of God."

You are welcome to join our Christmas Services, and I pray that you may find the peace that only Jesus can give this season. Have a Merry Christmas and a Happy and Blessed 2025!
